Fall Sale



Scholastic Book Fair Two book fairs are held a year, one in the fall and one in the spring. The spring book fair is a buy-one-get-one free sale. Loose change collected from your purchases is used to buy books from the Scholastic Book Fair for our school's library.



At both sales, teachers post their "wish lists" from which children and guardians can choose books to purchase for their children's classrooms.

Tricky Tray This is our biggest fundraiser! Donations are accepted all summer long and once school resumes in September. Send in your class basket and family basket donations and then plan to attend the tricky tray held on a Saturday in October.

Craft Fair This shopping event is held one Saturday in November. In addition to coming to the craft fair, bake sale donations will be accepted on the Friday before.

Dining Out Participation is in the form of eating at a designated restaurant on specified dates. A portion of the receipts are returned to the PTA in the form of cash.
